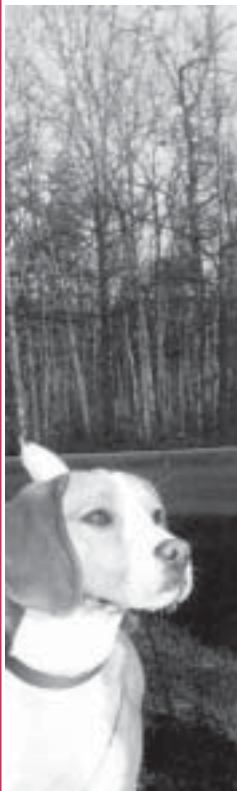

In 2004, activists in North America and Western Europe continued their strong traditions of direct action, but the year also saw actions in parts of the world that have not seen action in recent years, if ever before, such as Argentina, Turkey and Israel!

Although the actions are spread throughout the world against many animal abuse industries, one ALF cell made the message clear:

“to all who victimize the innocent: We're watching. And by axe, drill, or crowbar — we're coming through your door.

DIRECT ACTION REPORT



In 2004, close to **3,000*** animals were rescued from battery cages, broiler (meat) farms, vivisection labs, and from farms breeding animals for animal research and the pet trade. Animals rescued included:

Chickens (primarily hens): **916**

Rabbits: **696**

Rats: **556**

Mice: **540+**

Geese: **48**

Dogs (mostly beagles): **47**

Ducks: **26**

Gerbils: **26**

Turkeys: **25**

Finches: **5**

Chinchillas: **4**

Hamsters: **3**

Doves: **2**

Ferret: **1**

Pigs: **1**

Almost **15,000** animals— **9310 mink, two foxes, one raccoon, 20 stags, 5000 pheasants, and an unspecified number of partridges and other wild birds**— were released from cages, and given a chance to escape certain death, at fur farms and hunting estates. In addition, **frogs and crows** were liberated from vivisection labs in Russia, and in the UK the Lobster Liberation Front sabotaged a fishing boat, smashed pots and returned **30 lobsters and three crabs** to the sea.

**This list is not complete. The numbers of animals rescued in an action are not always reported; many other actions are never reported at all.*



the **GOLDEN** **BOLTCUTTERS**

MOST **INSPIRATIONAL**

Russian activists continued to impress us in 2004. Being an animal in a vivisection lab in Moscow has become a lot brighter. In six separate actions, activists entered Moscow State University and other vivisection labs in the city, and liberated 246 frogs, 204 rats, 6 rabbits and an unknown number of ravens and crows. Two foxes and a raccoon were also released from hunter's cages outside Moscow.

EMERGING **LIBERATIONISTS**

Argentine activists. In November, one rabbit was rescued from horrible conditions at a pet store in Buenos Aires. In December, 12 rabbits and 13 hens were liberated from a farm outside the capital city. We're hoping for great things in 2005!

LATEST **FASHION TREND?**

Doing away with the mask. Open rescue activists in Germany, Sweden, Austria, Australia and a few other countries rescued hundreds of chickens, ducks, geese and a piglet from factory farms in 2004.

BEST IMITATION **OF NOAH**

In a possible attempt to stock their own Ark, activists in Pennsylvania liberated beagles, chinchillas, gerbils, hamsters, rats, mice and a ferret from an agricultural school.

COMMUNIQUE **OR NOVEL?**

When the ALF liberated 47 animals from W.B. Saul High School's Laboratory Animal & Meat Science Program, they claimed the action in an 1,100 word news release.

LARGEST **LIBERATION**

In April, 6500 mink were released from their cages at a fur farm in northwest Spain. The farmer estimated 300,000 Euros in damages.

BEST **U.S. LIBERATION**

Proving that laboratory raids are still very much a possibility, the ALF liberated 88 mice and 313 rats from the University of Iowa in a meticulously planned and carefully executed action.

SABOTAGE

2004

OBJECT ACTION REPORT





By our count, there were **554 acts of sabotage** in defense of animals worldwide in 2004, an average of **1 ½ per day***.

The fur industry was the most common target (close to 200 separate actions). Huntingdon Life Sciences and related businesses were the second most popular targets. Activists also hit the meat, egg and dairy industries, rodeos, circuses, pet stores, bullfighting arenas, greyhound racing tracks, hunting stores and more. Countless windows were broken, locks glued, cars covered in paint stripper, tires slashed, slogans painted, and hunting platforms toppled. There were also at least 20 arson attacks on animal abusers worldwide in 2004, targeting fur farms, slaughterhouses, dairy farms, and destroying a 500-seat cockfighting arena in Louisiana.

**We counted 554 separate actions in 2004. When a butcher shop, fish shop and a meat truck had their locks glued on the same night, we counted three actions. If 10 windows were broken at a fur store, we counted that as one action.*

MOST ACTIVE

With well over 100 actions in 2004, the United Kingdom defended its crown, but close behind was activists in Sweden, Italy and Holland.

BREAKOUT PERFORMANCE

In October, three leather shops had their locks glued in Izmit, Turkey, in what may have been the first direct action for animals in the country. A few weeks later, two hunters vehicles in Izmit were torched!

WORST TOWN TO OWN A FUR STORE

Malmö, Sweden. Among the old castle and beautiful canals of Malmö are some kick-ass activists. One store (Palskonfektion) has been hit more than 40 times; the owner now sleeps in his store in an attempt to protect it.

HONORABLE MENTION

Fur stores in the Finnish towns of Turku and Tampere lost dozens of windows in 2004.

WORST PLACE TO RUN OUT OF CASH

Holland. In 2004, more than 35 ABN AMRO cash machines were sabotaged because of the bank's connections with the primate lab BPRC ("I can't find an ATM that works in this country!").

BEST VIDEO PERFORMANCE

ALF raid on the University of Iowa. In a performance worthy of an Oscar, masked activists (in a video released after the raid) calmly wait for the elevator, gently remove over 400 mice and rats from their cages, and in a burst of drama, smash dozens of computers and torture devices.

ANIMAL LIBERATION = HUMAN LIBERATION

In April, activists attacked a videoshop in Uddevalla, Sweden because it sold pornography involving animals, as well as humans.

BEST NEWSPAPER HEADLINE

"Did Fanatics Feed Gladys to Guinea Pigs?" (October 12). The British rag *The Mirror* speculated on the whereabouts of the remains of Gladys Hammond, a relative of the owners of the infamous Newchurch guinea pig farm; the grave desecration has been blamed on animal activists.

HONORABLE MENTION

"Army may help Oxford animal lab" (BBC, July 21).

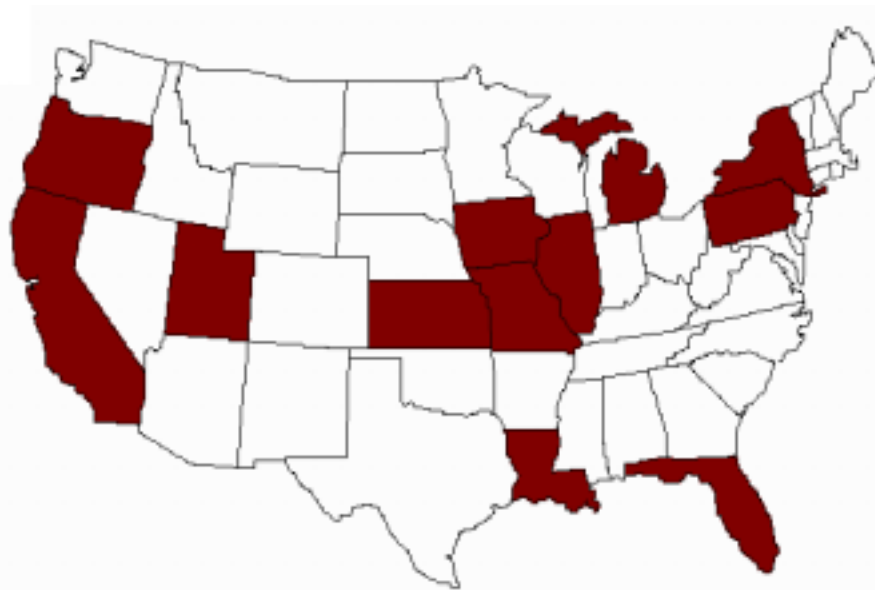
MOST CREATIVE

It's not always spray paint and superglue. In 2004, the home of a Covance employee in Germany was hit with Rotten fruit, a fire extinguisher was emptied through the mail slot of a fur store in Helsinki, a voodoo doll was left at the front door of a Newchurch farm employee, a pint of urine poured through an open window at the home of an HLS vet in New Jersey, and 1000 firecrackers were set off outside the home of HLS' CEO in Los Angeles.

01/09/04. Illinois. Four windows broken and “Animal Liberation Now” spray-painted at a KFC restaurant.

01/11/04. Daytona Beach, Florida. “Meat is Murder” spray-painted on a Chick-Fil-A restaurant.

02/03/04. Los Angeles. The tires of five Los Angeles Animal Control vans are slashed, and slogans painted on the building.

03/29/04. Portland, Oregon. Sumitomo (HLS customer) office building painted.

04/10/04. Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Four beagle puppies, two chinchillas, one ferret, 26 gerbils, three hamsters, 9 rats and two mice liberated from the W.B. Saul Agricultural High School.

04/19/04. Juno Beach, Florida. Locks glued and slogans painted at Seaboard Securities (HLS market maker).

04/20/04. New York. Over 200 pages of documents stolen from Forest Laboratories.

04/21/04. California. Sumitomo (HLS customer) employee wakes up to a home decorated with red paint.

05/03/04. Pensacola, Florida. Four windows smashed at fur store.

05/04/2004. California. Activists announced that over 2000 magazine subscription cards have been mailed out for executives at Santen (HLS customer).

05/16/04. Salt Lake City, Utah. 6 rabbits, 5 finches and 2 doves liberated from a vivisection lab at Brigham Young University. End of May. Salt Lake City, Utah. Vehicles sabotaged, chemicals spilled and slogans spray-painted at Brigham Young University’s animal research lab.

06/01/04. Pensacola, Florida. Four windows at fur store in damaged with etching fluid.

06/25/04. California. Offices of Johnson Matthey (HLS customer) covered with spray-painted messages, and locks glued.

07/09/04. Dr. James Walters, employee of Yamanouchi PharmaAmerica, woke up to find his SUV and house covered in spray-painted slogans.

07/10/04. Employee of Kent Financial Services (HLS market maker) had his sports car paint-stripped and tires slashed.

07/16/04. New Jersey. Pint of urine poured through open window at home of HLS vet Theresa Kusner.

07/18/04. Los Angeles. Activists visited HLS CEO Andrew Baker’s home and set off strip of 1,000 firecrackers, broke windows and destroyed a fountain, mailbox, and security cameras.

07/24/04. St. Louis, Missouri. Slogans spray-painted at HLS-customer Forest Labs’ facility.

07/27/04. New York. Toilets plugged, bathroom redecorated with paint and locks glued at a McDonalds.

07/28/04. Florida. Locks glued and slogans painted at Domestic Securities (HLS Market Maker), and at a Sumitomo (HLS customer) subsidiary.

08/04/04. New York. Slogans painted, wires and pipes sabotaged at Forest Labs’ Long Island facility.

08/08/04. Louisiana. ALF burnt down 500-seat cockfighting arena.

09/06/04. New Orleans, Louisiana. Windows etched at Saks Fifth Avenue.

09/26/04. Los Angeles. Home of L.A. Animal Services employee covered in red paint.

10/02/04. Grand Rapids, Michigan. Ringling Bros. circus train cars painted and truck windows etched; slogans painted, locks glued and windows smashed at hosting arena.

10/07/04. Los Angeles. Red paint splashed at entrance to Los Angeles Animal Services.

10/17/04. Four windows smashed at a McDonalds.

10/27/04. California. Slogans painted on home of HLS-CEO Andrew Baker.

11/02/04. E-mail accounts of HLS market maker’s Sterne Agee and SIG clogged in electronic attack.

11/14/04. Topeka, Kansas. Locks glued, speakers vandalized at three KFC’s.

11/14/04. Iowa City, Iowa. 88 mice and 313 rats liberated from University of Iowa psychology laboratory; more than 30 computers destroyed, documents removed.

11/15/04. Los Angeles. Los Angeles Animal Services manager received bomb threat at work.

11/19/04. Ann Arbor, Michigan. BOC Gases (HLS supplier) painted.

11/20/04. Los Angeles. Locks glued at home of Los Angeles Animal Services employee.

11/21/04. California. 14 windows broken and slogans painted at a McDonalds in California.

11/22/04. New York. Red paint splattered on Stony Brook Fur Shop and brick thrown through glass door.

12/09/04. New York. Host of a party for HLS customer Forest Laboratories flooded with over 1000 large e-mails.

SABOTAGE

January 2004 (Finland) During January, slogans were etched into the windows of four fur stores in Turku; etching fluid also used to write slogans on 20 windows at six fur stores in Helsinki.

January 2004 (Germany) 27 fur coats in three different stores were damaged.

01/01/04 (UK) Rocks thrown through the windows of the home of David Hall, who operates the Newchurch guinea pig farm. Bottles of red paint were then thrown through the broken windows.

01/02/04 (Norway) Empty mink farm in Harstad damaged by fire.

01/02/04 (Sweden) Three windows broken at a fur store in Gaevle.

01/05/04 (Germany) The home of Stefan Friedrichs Gromoll, a Covance employee, was attacked with rotten fruit.

01/05/04 (UK) HLS-supplier Cambridge Export Documents had their locks glued and slogans painted.

01/05/04 (UK) Activists visited the home of Sally Hall and filled the water pipes with cement (Hall family operates the Newchurch guinea pig farm).

01/07/04 (Italy) Two dairy farms in Formigine visited by activists. Machinery was vandalized and several tractors destroyed by fire.

01/09/04 (USA) Four windows broken and "Animal Liberation Now" spray-painted at a KFC restaurant in Illinois.

01/10/04 (Sweden) Six stores that sell fur in Jonkoping had locks glued and slogans spray-painted.

01/11/04 (Germany) Locks glued and red paint poured at Harlan, a breeder of dogs for vivisection.

01/11/04 (USA) "Meat is Murder" spray-painted on a Chick-Fil-A restaurant in Daytona Beach, Florida.

01/11-16/04 (Italy) During a week of action against Morini farm, one of Europe's largest breeders of animals for vivisection, the homes of three vivisectors who use animals from Morini received spray-painted slogans, locks were glued and slogans painted at the Neuroscience Department at Torino University, and another Morini customer had five liters of paint dumped at their entrance.

01/14/04 (UK) The main window and glass door of a KFC in Chesterfield were broken.

01/14/04 (Germany) Anti-fur slogans painted on the home of a Peek & Clompenburg (store that sells fur) employee.

01/15/04 (Netherlands) Yamanouchi employee had car tires slashed at his home in Zeist.

01/15/04 (UK) Six vehicles at Water Farm Goat Centre (vivisection suppliers) were covered with paint stripper and had their tires slashed.

01/16/04 (UK) New BMW of Kenneth Broadley (Cardiff University vivisector) was covered with paint stripper.

01/18/04 (UK) 7 vehicles parked at Sigma-Aldrich Chemicals (HLS supplier) in Dorset had their tires slashed, and several windows broken.

01/19-22/04 (Austria) Five fur stores in Vienna had their locks glued.

01/19/04 (UK) The director of HLS-supplier Fisher Scientific had three cars in his driveway covered with paint stripper.

01/20/04 (Finland) Four fur stores in Turku had slogans etched in their windows.

01/20/04 (UK) HLS-supplier Phenomenex lost two large windows.

01/20/04 (UK) Tires slashed and windows broken on a delivery vehicle at Nottingham Seafoods.

01/22/04 (Spain) Truck belonging to a meat company was torched in Pamplona.

01/25/04 (Netherlands) The car of fur-trader J. Floor in Houten was destroyed by fire.

01/25/04 (Germany) Yamanouchi's German HQ was visited; all the cars in a basement garage were covered with paint stripper.

01/28/04 (Australia) Signs advertising a rodeo in Ballarat were vandalized.

01/30/04 (Netherlands) The home of a Chiron employee in Amsterdam was damaged with spray-paint, red paint and etching fluid.

01/30/04 (Netherlands) Two branches of ABN AMRO bank had their cash machines, windows and doors vandalized.
